Political & Campaign Hours  
July 1, 2023 – June 30, 2025

ARW members contribute many hours to our Republican cause. Attached is a tally sheet where you can record your hours for the two-year period July 1, 2023 - June 30, 2025. It is often difficult to recreate the past, but try to recall events you participated in, committees you worked on, etc., and approximate when they occurred OR track them contemporaneously—daily, weekly or monthly; estimate your time rounding up to the next hour. A handwritten submittal is all that is required or use the attached form. Submit your hours monthly at a club meeting or email directly to our ARW Awards Chairman. You may report a block of total hours or break down by category as suggested below. You will be surprised to see the hours you invest in these efforts. Thank you for making a difference!

Examples of hours to record in the ARW, AzFRW and NFRW columns:

- Attendance at Club, State and National Federation meetings, conventions and events; includes door-to-door travel
- Federation committee work – hours in meetings, preparing for meetings, working on committee projects (communications, Caring for America, etc.)
- Volunteering at any Republican or Federation Headquarters (local, county, state, national).
- Preparing an article for the newsletter or an e-blast
- Participation in any forum, including ZOOM, sponsored by the Federation or Republican Party

AZGOP / County / Legislative District, Other Political OR Campaign columns would include time worked in support of electing Republicans to local, State and Federal offices during the two-year timeframe OR for Political Causes (does not include full-time compensated hours).

Examples of these hours are:

- Candidates/Causes Campaign/Get Out the Vote/Voter Registration/Community activities, etc. – volunteering, gathering signatures, installing signs
- Work done at home on mailings, making posters, making phone calls, computer work, etc.
- Time in session and door-to-door travel to AZGOP Meetings/Conventions, Maricopa County Meetings and Republican National Committee Conventions
- Time spent as a Precinct/State Committeeman, Member at Large, etc.
- Working at the Polls Election Day or other election-related tasks
- Writing legislators, elected officials, including RTS system
- Attending other organizations' political events and activities

Track of the number of Political Phone Calls you make – whether it's phone banking or calls made for Federation or other political organizations' business and activities. The time you spend making calls should be recorded in one of the categories mentioned above.
